

PUBLIC NOTICE

**BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE DOUBLE YELLOW LINES
ON GRANGE LANE, BROMHAM, AND A LOADING BAY ON STAGSDEN ROAD,
BROMHAM**

Reasons for Proposals:

It is proposed to introduce a short stretch of double yellow lines opposite the entrance of Bromham CofE Primary School on Grange Lane, Bromham, in order to deter inconsiderate parking, to keep the entrance unobstructed and to promote road safety for all.

It is proposed to introduce a dedicated loading bay on Stagsden Road, Bromham, to enable the loading and unloading of goods to and from commercial premises in the area while minimising any impact on traffic flows.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce 'No waiting at any time' restrictions (double yellow lines) on the following length of road:

A	Grange Lane, Bromham
(i)	On its southern kerb from the westernmost boundary of number 37 to the easternmost boundary of number 33.

2. To introduce a 'Loading Only' parking bay on the following length of road:

A	Stagsden Road, Bromham
(i)	On its northern kerb starting from the easternmost point of the easternmost taper of the BP petrol station exit and continuing in an easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres.
