BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL
(BRIDGE END, BROMHAM AND BROMHAM ROAD, BIDDENHAM)
(20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 7th October 2020 Bedford Borough Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which is detailed below:-

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce a 20mph speed limit on the following lengths of road:

A	Bridge End, Bromham
(i)	From the common boundary between property nos. 14 & 16 Bridge End to Bromham Road, Biddenham.
B	Bromham Road, Biddenham
(i)	From Bridge End, Bromham to a point approximately 2 metres east of the common boundary between property nos. 124b & 126 Bromham Road.

Date of Operation: This Order will come into force on 9th October 2020 or as soon as practicable after this date.

High Court Challenge: Any person who desires to question the validity of this Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date of this Notice, make application for that purpose to the High Court.
