



PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (GRANGE LANE AND STAGSDEN ROAD, BROMHAM) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING BAY) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 23rd December 2020 Bedford Borough Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which is detailed below:-

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce a 'No waiting at any time' restriction (double yellow lines) on the following length of road:

A	Grange Lane, Bromham
(i)	On its southern kerb from the westernmost boundary of number 37 to the easternmost boundary of number 35.

2. To introduce a 'Loading Only' parking bay on the following length of road:

A	Stagsden Road, Bromham
(i)	On its northern kerb starting from the easternmost point of the easternmost taper of the BP petrol station exit and continuing in an easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres.

Date of Operation: This Order came into force on 1st January 2021.

High Court Challenge: Any person who desires to question the validity of this Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date of this Notice, make application for that purpose to the High Court.
