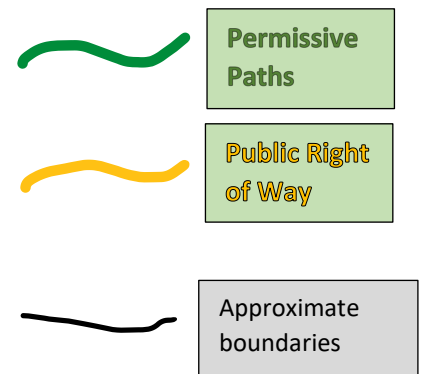
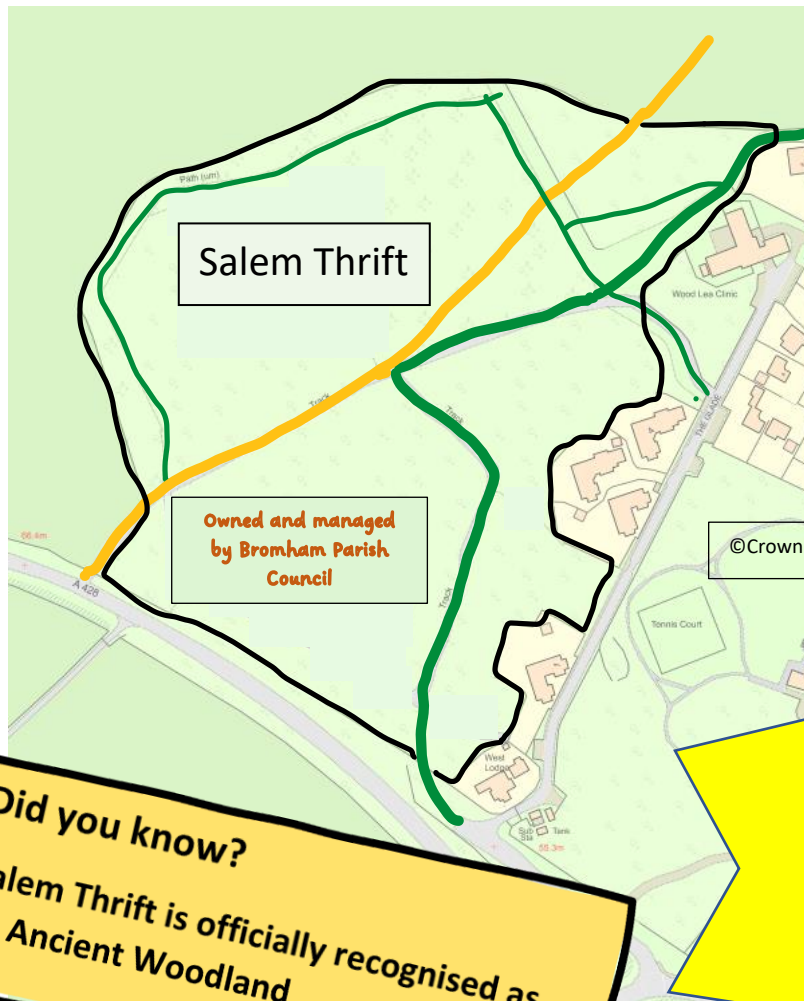

Salem Thrift is a really important place. It has been a managed woodland since at least 1600 and is probably several hundred years older.

This is why we are very keen to see the woods enjoyed by all...but we do need to protect them. Please keep to the paths and do not walk where there are flowers.



The Primroses took over from the widespread snowdrops during March and are now well established

The **Wood Anemone** is one of the plants that indicate to scientists that this is an Ancient Woodland.

Most of the grass-like leaves nearby belong to the Bluebells which are just now coming into bloom
